PROGRAM INFORMATION

This program is designed to provide students with knowledge of selected academic subjects at the high school level. It focuses on developing, improving, and upgrading skills in English, French, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and Computer Literacy. The skills obtained are the equivalent of those acquired following the completion of specific courses at the Grade 11 and/or 12 level in New Brunswick high schools.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The subjects are offered on a self-paced self-study approach with continual classroom instructor support to provide clarification on course material as required. With students taking responsibility for learning times, they are able to work independently at their own pace, enabling timely completion of the course. Classes are offered Monday – Fridays from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm. Students can attend full-time or part-time choosing from full days, ½ days (morning/afternoon) or specific days per week that best fit the student's schedule; i.e., Mon/Wed, Tues/Thurs, etc. **Students select their own schedule!**

When the number of applicants exceeds the number of openings in this program, applicants will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to this program, applicants must have successfully completed at least the high school program of Grade 9/10 studies, or Intermediate Academic Studies, or the equivalent through recognized adult education training.
