POLICY STATEMENT

Compliance with this requirement will be demonstrated in the preparation by the faculty member of a course outline that adheres in all respects to the requirements of the Curriculum Standard for that program. Approval of the competent authority is required for each course outline.

Learning strategies, teaching methods and resources must meet the needs of the learners.

Recognition of the student's academic success will be done by the handing out of appropriate certification documents.
