GUIDING PRINCIPLE

NBCC supports and recognizes student achievement in academic excellence through the awarding of various academic distinctions.

POLICY STATEMENT

2.1 NBCC, through the granting of Honours Status, as well as the Academic Excellence Award, recognizes academic achievement upon graduation from a Diploma or Certificate program.

2.2 Honours

2.2.1 Honours designation recognizes a student's overall academic achievement upon successful completion of a certificate/diploma.

2.2.2 Students must have successfully completed all requirements of the certificate or diploma (including all term courses and work practicum), and be eligible for graduation.

2.2.3 During the transition Academic year 2011/12, the grade point average of 3.30 will be recognized as honors. However in subsequent years a grade point average of 3.5 will be required.

2.3 Academic Excellence Award

2.3.1 The Academic Excellence Award recognizes the top student in each program delivery who has successfully completed the program, and achieved the highest academic standing.

2.3.2 Students must have successfully completed all requirements of the certificate or diploma (including all term courses and work practicum) and be eligible for graduation.
