

Wage Gap Action Plan Scholarships

Value (Quantity): one-year full tuition - up to \$2,600.00 (57)

Distribution as follows:

- Half of the value of the tuition at the beginning of the school year,
- Second half of the value of the tuition at the beginning of the second session upon successful completion of the first session.

Eligibility: Students who are residents of New Brunswick and accepted for the fall session or winter session into an eligible program of study, whether you are continuing your education or re-entering the school system as a mature student, may qualify for one of these scholarships. (The [eligible programs of study](#) are subject to change annually in the spring.)

Selection Criteria:

- Applicants must be accepted into a designated program.
- Applicants must answer in an essay the four questions outlined on the eligibility guidelines page.
